3 MINUTES

3.1 Matters Arising

Youth Issues

Mrs Barnett had investigated the provision of a youth club worker and had discovered that the youth club is now open on Friday nights. The committee agreed that the provision of a new youth room or centre should be included in the Village Action Plan. It was also agreed that a closer working relationship should be fostered between the youth worker and the Parish Council.

4 Recreation Ground Car Park

The committee received the quote, but agreed to defer the work to the main car park due to the problems being experienced by the Sports & Social Club with drainage. The drains are blocked and have caused several incidences of flooding to the toilets of the club. The committee agrees to have a drain survey to identify the problem. The Clerk is requested to organise for this survey and to obtain two quotes for the work.

It was identified that the Sports & Social Club toilets need to be updated and repaired and it was agreed that an action plan for the work should be drawn up once the drain problem was resolved.

5 Allotment Ditch

It was agreed that Mr DJ Flynn should be awarded the job to clear the ditch.

7 Christmas Lights

The committee awarded the job for the Christmas lights to Mr DJ Flynn. The Clerk will liase with him nearer the time.
