9. APOLOGIES

An apology for absence was received from Mr K Speer (Bowling).

10. MINUTES

The Minutes of the Meeting held on 22nd February 2007, were received and signed.

11. Matters Arising

The Clerk reported that an invoice from the Groundsman for the hours he worked repairing the damage caused by the Rugby Club, had been received. The Clerk is awaiting a reply from the book-keeper as to the hourly rate that the Rugby Club should be charged for this work.

The Clerk also reported the electrician has repaired the wiring to the electronic noticeboard and Polycomp has been advised. No reply has been received from Polycomp as yet.

12. REPRESENTATIVE'S REPORTS

Stoolball

Mrs Hooper asked if the Club could have permission to park on the Recreation Ground on Sunday 15th July 2007 and Sunday 1st September 2007. The Committee could see no problem with this and Mrs Hooper agreed to liaise with Mr Feest (Cricket Club).

Football

Mr Jupp reported that all was going well with the Football Club. He advised members the Club had had an excellent Race Night at the Village Hall on 3rd March 2007 and had raised £900 for their funds.

He handed the Clerk a list of cleaning duties that needed doing in the changing rooms and the Clerk was instructed to bring this to the cleaner's attention.

Mr Jupp informed the Committee that the Football Club had procured mini goal posts for £10 and had agreed to donate them to the Parish Council, if the Council could provide the nets. The Assistant Clerk was advised the size required and asked to order them straightaway.

Bowling

Mrs Henly had nothing to report but let the Clerk have a copy of the fixture list for the Parish Office.

13. ADDITIONAL ITEMS

13.1 Hamilton Cole

The Clerk reported that the Parish Office had received a call from the Caretaker advising the fluorescent light fitment in changing room 3 was not working. AES Electrical was due to start work at the Sports and Social Club very shortly and Mr Anderson from that company agreed that would be included under his remit. The Clerk was surprised to receive an invoice from Hamilton Cole for the work done as this had not been agreed by the parish Office. The Clerk was instructed to ascertain from Hamilton Cole who had given them the instruction to do the work, especially as the wrong light fitment for a changing room had been installed and AES had had to replace it.

13.2 The People's Millions

The Clerk circulated to the Clubs present a copy of how they could apply for this Lottery funding.

Mrs Barnett thanked the representatives for their attendance and closed the meeting at 7.57pm.
