5. APOLOGIES

Apologies for absence were received from Mr J Jupp (Football).

6. MINUTES

The Minutes of the Meeting held on 31st May 2007 were received and signed.

7. Matters Arising

The Clerk advised members that a letter had been received from Southern Water, following a site visit by their surveyor. It was reported the damaged pipe was a storm drain and nothing to do with Southern Water and to try both the County Council and the District Council. The Clerk reported that letters had been sent to both Councils.

The Clerk also informed members that the report had been received from CJ Uden concerning their findings following the second attempt to survey the damaged pipe with a camera. This was to be discussed in full during the meeting directly after.

The Clerk reported that the Rugby Club had contacted the Parish Office to advise they were going to make good the ground at Cousins Way, following the removal of the metal sleeves. As a tractor needed access to the Recreation Ground, the Clerk had given Mr Leadbeater's contact details to Alex Steele, as he was the only keyholder.

Following an urgent request from the Cricket Club concerning the double doors into the changing rooms, which would not open, the Clerk had asked the caretaker to investigate. He had found nothing wrong and it was

suggested it may be that particular key. Other Sports Club representatives confirmed they had no trouble opening the door.

Mr Feest reported a mixed start to the season with the 1st Team struggling but the 2nd and 3rd Teams doing well.
