### **14. MINUTES**

### **15. REPRESENTATIVES' REPORTS**

#### **Football**

Mr Jupp stated he had nothing to report other than they were three games into the season.. He then confirmed that the water was being logged as requested. Mr. Jupp also asked for the showers to be checked in the changing rooms as they were not working efficiently. He will obtain a quote for a deep overall clean of the showers which he will send to the council office. Once the showers have been cleaned it was agreed that a once monthly thorough clean should be added to the cleaners rota.. Mr. Jupp also stated that an agreement had been reached with the Cricket Club to share the storage facilities.

#### **Bowling**

Mrs Henly said the bowling was going well and the Club were in third position in the league.

She advised that the club had received two nice letters from the Isle of Wight and Purley Clubs thanking Pulborough for their hospitality. She then finished by saying that the club had new members and also that this weekend was the end of the season.

#### **Pythons**

Mr. James advised that the club was relegated last year, but had won their first two games. The under 11's had to be disbanded due to lack of numbers but

there were teams for the under 7's, 8's 9's and 10's. The club was using the same pitch as last year.

Mr. James also asked for a key to the changing rooms. Another key will need to be cut. It was agreed that a signed receipt would be provided.

Mr. James also reported that twelve helpers had been CRB checked.
