DETAILED SPECIFICATION

All materials/components company with British Standards (where applicable), or other equivalent. They will all be delivered to site in manufactures wrapping where provided. All storage/handling shall be in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

1. PRELIMS

2. SITE PREPARATION

- 2.1. REMOVAL: existing synthetic surface to be removed, all arisings on site disposed with off site.
- 2.2. CLEAN: thoroughly clean the existing porous macadam sports surface.
- 2.3. TREATMENT: Chemically treat the existing surface with moss and algae substance.
- 2.4. EDGE DETAIL: create chase/channel into existing tarmac surface to full perimeter.
- 2.5. DRAINAGE: drill holes into existing surface on a grid bases and fill with pea-shingle to aid in drainage

3. SURFACING

- 3.1. SHOCK-PAD: installation of either an in-situ rubber pad or pre-formed, depth variable to suit specific applications.
- 3.2. SYNTHETIC SPORT SURFACE: installation of a Premium (needlepunch) MultiSport Synthetic surface 15mm, sand dressed. This surface is extremely durable and caters for all sports including Netball, Football, Basketball and Hockey. It is low maintenance and hard wearing with a low sand content.
- 3.3. LINE MARKINGS: inlaid into the surface at 50mm standard width, in different colours for each specific sport court.

4. FENCING

- 4.1. FENCING: installation of 3m high rebound ball court system, typically manufactured from 6mm vertical wires and twin 8mm horizontals. The 1.2m rebound system is 66x50mm with the remaining 1.8m
 200x50m. Galvanised and powder coated to our standard colour range. Fencing heights range from 1m 5m and can be adjusted to suite requirements accordingly. (Kick boards can be added)
- 4.2. GATES: installed within fencing system, standard single leaf pedestrian gate 1.2m width and double vehicle access gate 3m width (more can be added as required).
- 4.3. GOALS: installed within fencing system recess goals with integrated basketball hoops.

5. FLOODLIGHTING

Installation of columns including all excavation, foundation and fixing works. A 415 volts - 3 phase connection power supply is required. All connecting to an on/off control pillar electrical box. All systems are designed talking in to account all necessary project specifications. Subject to site survey. Planning may also be required.

6. **SITE CLEARANCE:** where stated all spoil is removed from site with all areas reinstated.
